Results of Annual General Meeting and Trading Update

The Board of Babylon Pump and Power Ltd is pleased to advise that all resolutions put to the annual general meeting of shareholders held today were passed on a poll with the requisite majority. The Chairman voted all undirected proxies held at his discretion in favour of each resolution.

In accordance with Listing Rule 3.13.2 and section 251AA of the Corporations Act 2011, details of the results and the proxies received in respect of each resolution are set out in the attached summary.

No other resolutions were put to the meeting.

The Company is also pleased to advise that the unaudited management accounts for the four months ended 31 October 2023 have been finalised and reflect EBITDA equating to approximately 62% of the full FY23 normalised EBITDA reported at today's AGM. Furthermore, demand for the Company's stand-alone hybrid power units continues to grow. These factors support the growth story outlined at today's AGM.
